



AGREEMENT
on
cooperation between
Academy of Public Administration,
office of the President of the Republic of
Moldova
and Latvian School of Public
Administration



The Academy of Public Administration, office of the President of the Republic of Moldova represented by the Rector Alexander ROMAN and Latvian School of Public Administration represented by the Director Ugis RUSMANIS (“the parties”),

Guided historical traditions of friendship of people of the Republic of Moldova and Latvia,

Striving to make mutual contribution into the development of theory and practice in training public servants and local government officials;

Agreed on the following.

Article 1

The Parties in line with the national legislation of the states, in the framework of their statutes and responsibilities will facilitate combination of their effort in the development of training public servants and local government officials.

Article 2

The cooperation under this Agreement will be executed in the following directions:

- exchange of the best experience on training of public servants and local government officials;
- exchange of faculty and experts with the purpose of professional development of public institution staff;
- joint development and realization of bilateral training seminars and courses in the field of European Integration;
- exchange of the best experience in the area of human resource management and exchange of best educational didactical materials;
- participation in the exhibitions within the Parties;
- exchange of the best experience in administrative reform;
- conduct of joint research;

- joint search, development and execution of international projects aimed at development of public administration and local government machinery;
- holding joint communication events in training public servants and local government officials (round tables, conferences, symposiums);

Article 3

The Parties will specifically agree on the conditions of financial support for the bilateral events.

Article 4

This Agreement does not interfere with the Parties' rights and obligations following from other concluded by them agreements, including international ones.

Article 5

This Agreement may be changed and amended annually on the initiative of any Party after agreeing and signing the appendix to this Agreement.

Article 6

Any disputes and disagreements emerging in the course of implementation of this Agreement, will be solved by means of joint negotiations.

Article 7

The Agreement will take effect on its signing by both Parties and will remain in effect unless any Party wishing to terminate the Agreement gives the other Party three months noting in writing.

Article 8

The Agreement will be implemented by the means of signing a mutually agreed plan of cooperation for the coming year.

Article 9

This Agreement is written in two copies in English.
