## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

CRACOW SCHOOL OF BUSINESS CRACOW UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS

AND

## ACADEMY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

CRACOW SCHOOL OF BUSINESS at CRACOW UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS, located in Cracow, Poland, and ACADEMY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION located in Chisinau, Moldova – sign this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the development of academic cooperation in international education in areas of mutual interest and expertise. The collaboration established by this MOU will enhance the intellectual life and cultural development at both institutions, and will contribute to increased international cooperation. To meet these goals, CRACOW SCHOOL OF BUSINESS at CRACOW UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS and ACADEMY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION have agreed that in support of their mutual interests in the field of education and research:

## I. The two Educational Institutions will:

- (i) Collaborate on the development of educational programs for postgraduate and MBA students. Such programs may take place for a period of one term, semester, or academic year. The academic standing of such student shall be determined by the host institution. Visiting students will be granted the rights and privileges of students in the host country in accordance with the regulations of the host institution relating to students and will be admitted under the terms and conditions relevant to the Host University. Accreditation for the academic work carried out by students during the period of study at the host institution will be at the discretion of the student's home university.
- (ii) Cooperate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interest.
- (iii) Promote appropriate joint research projects and joint courses of study, with particular emphasis on internationally funded projects, as well as exchange of information about conferences, workshops and mutual assistance to participate in them.
- (iv) Conduct short courses, cultural projects, study tours, and other activities as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of such activity.

- II. Academic members of staff and other personnel of one partner institution may spend periods not normally exceeding one academic year in the other partner institution. In supporting such arrangements, all financial matters, including travel costs, salary payments and other compensations, are subject to individual negotiation, and will normally be the responsibility of the persons involved and their home institution.
- III. In the implementation of other cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed upon, and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the program.
- IV. This proposed cooperation does not preclude in any way, shape, or form CRACOW SCHOOL OF BUSINESS at CRACOW UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS right to enter into agreements with other local colleges and universities. However, such overtures may not contravene this MOU.
- V. The success of the partnership in achieving a broad balance in the respective contributions will be periodically reviewed by the partner institutions.
- VI. This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for an unlimited period from that date unless terminated, revoked or modified by mutual written agreement between the parties, and may be expanded upon by mutual written agreement. Either party may terminate the Agreement at any time by notifying the other party, in writing, four months prior to termination.
